St. John Bosco Fire Door: Quote to work towards: £11,400, Donations: £2,739. Secondly, we can use this month and maybe June if necessary to donate as much as we can to get it done sooner, the work will only take an estimated 3 weeks, and then the Church will be fully open, and the Presbytery can be rented after we block off access to the Church from the house.
